

Computers can do several other things besides carrying out calculations. In fact, there are few things that a modern computer is not able to do.

Computers have memory. That is, they can store a lot of data or information. They can keep words, pictures and sounds in their memory and give you the information within a fraction of a second when you need it.

Computer can process the data or the information according to the instructions given to them. A modern computer can follow thousands of instructions within a fraction of a second. Only the instructions have to be given in a language that the computer understands. A set of code instructions written for a computer is known as a program. Writing a computer program is a specialized task.

A computer on its own does not make judgments about the instructions given to it. It follows the instructions blindly. That is why, the instructions have to be written very very carefully. The instructions must cover every step involved in an operation. If you miss a step, the computer will not correct it.
